- All homework will be set on Google Classroom. Login details will be sent home and homework will be starting on Friday 24th September. The due date will be the following Friday.
- A list of spellings will need to be practised at home. Some of these are from the National Curriculum list of statutory words. Others practise spelling patterns we are learning at Year 5. Spelling lists will be set according to the child's ability.
- Children are expected to read every night for approximately 20-30 minutes.
- Times tables need to be practiced. This can be done in many ways including using Times Table Rock Stars.
- A topic task will be set each term. This will be an opportunity for children to show off their creative skills.
- A homework task may occasionally be set on Purple Mash. However, the task will still be listed on Google Classroom, explaining to the children what they need to do.
